


Information for Gallant Gator Volunteer Readers

Thanks for signing up to be a Gallant Gator Reader! The guidance counselors have made it super easy for volunteers to participate in this program. For anyone who has never done this before, this document is an overview of what needs to be done.

Step 1 - Sign in as a volunteer in the front office. You must have already registered as a volunteer for the current school year. You will need your driver's license to check-in.

Step 2 - Go to the media center to get your materials.

The cabinet containing the Gallant Gators materials is immediately to left upon entering the media center.




Find the binder for your child's grade (eg, "K", "1", "2"). In the binder you will find a sign in sheet for your child's class that lists each character trait – please sign the book out while you are using it in the unlikely event that someone else is looking for it at the same time

Find the the sheet that corresponds with the trait you are reading, it lists the book, along with talking points to lead the class discussion. Each character trait also has a corresponding poster, which can be found on the bottom shelf. See below for an example of the handout for the “Kindness” character trait.

Step 3 – Go back to the office and ask them to call down and see if you teacher is ready. Bring the book, handout and poster to your child’s class at the assigned time. Read the story and discuss the character trait using the talking points and questions from the handout. This should take approximately 15 minutes.
